## **URC TO PURCHASE RHI ASSETS**

Universal Robina Corporation ("URC") has reached an agreement with Roxas Holdings, Inc. ("RHI") and some of its wholly-owned subsidiaries on the purchase of RHI's sugar mill, ethanol plant and other investment properties in La Carlota City, Negros Occidental (the "Transaction").

The closing of the Transaction remains subject to relevant approvals, such as the approval of the Philippine Competition Commission ("PCC"), and other closing conditions. The Parties hope to achieve completion before the start of the next Crop Year.

Aside from the operational synergies that will be achieved between La Carlota and existing URC operations in sugar, this acquisition is also intended to help sugarcane planters increase their productivity, as well as help local communities in Negros by providing more opportunities.

In addition, the acquisition will allow URC to continue in its efforts to support the development of the sugar industry in the Philippines.

### **URC**

Universal Robina Corporation (URC), the first "Philippine-based Pan ASEAN Multinational", is the largest listed food company in the Philippines and has established a strong presence in the ASEAN markets. URC is among the Philippines' pioneers in the industry, having been in operations since 1954 when Mr. John L. Gokongwei, Jr. established Universal Corn Products, a cornstarch manufacturing plant. URC is engaged in a wide variety of businesses. Its core branded consumer foods group includes manufacturing and distribution of snack foods, beverages and grocery products. In the Philippines, the company is also into food ingredients (flour milling, sugar milling and refining) and allied agro-industrial products (hog farming, animal feed milling, glucose, soy products and veterinary compounds). URC has also invested in ancillary segments mainly focusing on renewable energy to further add value and process by-products to produce biogas, fuel grade bio-ethanol and power (biomass cogeneration).

### About RHI

Roxas Holdings, Inc. (RHI), a bio-sugar and bio-energy company, is the largest integrated sugar business in the Philippines. It manages sugar miller/refiner Central Azucarera Don Pedro, Inc. in Nasugbu, Batangas; sugar miller Central Azucarera de la Carlota, Inc.; ethanol producers Roxol Bioenergy Corporation in La Carlota, Negros Occidental and San Carlos Bioenergy, Inc. in San Carlos, Negros Occidental; and RHI Agri-business Development Corporation.
